A Message From Your Board President

Owners/Residents:

The Restriping garage project is drawing to a close. It has been a challenge for residents, as well as the staff. I would like to thank everyone for their patience and cooperation. Sometimes our attempts to keep the building properly maintained, requires inconvenience and I appreciate your understanding.

You should have all received the first notice of our annual meeting by now and the election of the Board for December 14th. If you have not received this please notify the management office. As a reminder, for anyone who wishes to run for the Board, your letter of intent must be received in the office by November 4th. At our November 14th Board meeting we will be approving the budget for 2018. The details are being mailed out now. The Board is recommending that we not fully fund our reserves but that requires a vote of our owners, so included in your budget are proxies and instructions for voting. It is very important that you get your proxies in prior to the meeting. If we don't have a proper quorum we will be unable to pass the budget.

The Board appointed three of our owners to the newly formed design committee. They will begin the process of interviewing and recommending a design firm that will put together a plan for updating the common areas throughout the building. Recognizing that we would undertake this project in stages, a complete plan will give us better focus as we proceed with upgrades.

The damages our building sustained from Hurricane Irma have all been addressed but we continue to work with our landscaper on replacing the landscaping that was destroyed. We are hopeful that many of palms that were damaged will recover. We will be watching them over the next several months to see how they progress.
