The Winterfest Boat Parade is approaching and we would like to remind you of our policies & procedures during this event:

- 1. Valet parking for guests and residents will be --as always-- on a first come first serve basis. The parking garage will be closed (except for residents) at 3:00 pm, or sooner, depending on valet parking capacity. Based on previous years, we expect full capacity to be reached well before 3:00 p.m. Once the front garage gate is closed, everyone must enter and leave the building through the back gates. Residents and guests retrieving their cars from valet parking after 3:00 p.m. should take their tickets to the back gate, not the front entrance.
- 2. To emphasize: Valet guest parking is on a first come first serve basis equally for guests and residents. If you are a resident who uses valet parking for your second vehicle, there may or may not be space available for you on Boat Parade day.
- 3. All guests will be provided with wrist bands for ID purposes. No guests will be allowed into the building un-less they are on the guest list and they must be wearing the wrist band. Residents must provide the management office with a guest list not later than 5:00pm Thursday, December 7th. You may include all "maybe" guests on the list as well. Guests on the list must pick up their wrist bands at the front desk upon arrival. Contrary to our practice, guests will be allowed to enter the building without being announced to the resident.
- 4. The Club Room and patio outside the Club Room cannot be reserved for private functions but it will be available for use by all residents and their guests.
- 5. The front desk will not "buzz in" residents through the lobby entrance doors, so it is imperative that all residents carry and use their fobs during the entire day.

 If you are not going to use your parking space on the day of the parade, we ask you to please authorize us to use it for extra valet parking. Please e-mail
